

ABOUT HOME BLOCK

Home Block is one of three historic chardonnay blocks at Spring Ridge Vineyard. It is the highest elevated block, spaning between 840 to 805 feet above sea level. This block is 1.4 acres in size. Planted in 1981, Home block was the first vineyard block established at Spring Ridge Vineyards. The vines are clone 4 and own rooted.

Home Block consists of a soil blend of 27% sand, 48% silt, and 25% clay.

ABOUT SPRING RIDGE VINEYARD

Spring Ridge Vineyard sits on an eastfacing ridge in the Santa Cruz mountains. The ridge ascends from 500 to 1700 feet above sea level. The maritime climate of the offers San Francisco Bay cool, crisp sunny afternoons warm, mornings and perfect conditions for creating growing chardonnay and pinot noir. The soil at Spring Ridge Vineyard consists of sedimentary rock, 1 to 3 million years old, at a shallow and mid level depth, perfect for the expression of our grapes. We strive to protect and nurture the entire ecological community of Spring Ridge Vineyard, and are dedicated to stewarding and replenishing the land we inhabit.
